The Alliance for ALB needs your support for the 2016 season. This year we will see the use of the new BHS all artificial baseball and softball field in addition to the Fieldturf infield renovations at Mulcahy Stadium done by ALB in 2009.

Statewide the Alliance is committed to improving facilities for our youth baseball players around Alaska.

In addition the Alliance will continue to advocate for a plan to renovate and relocate the 50 years old Mulcahy Stadium in 2015.

With the addition of all Anchorage area high schools in 2014 having artificial football/soccer fields this gives those sports an opportunity to extend their seasons. While some of those fields allow for early season training for baseball teams, they do not accommodate baseball games.

The Alliance believes that using this Fieldturf technology on some additional baseball fields to include infield renovations throughout the state will help encourage baseball development.

A partnership with Polar Little League, the Anchorage Parks Foundation, the Alliance will help renovate two Little League fields at Polar Little League in Mt. View from repurposed older Fieldturf harvested from the Anchorage Football Stadium in 2013. This is an example of joint partnership's that the Alliance encourages.

The new Taylar Young Memorial Field at South Anchorage High School is another collaborative venture between the South Baseball Boosters, the community and the Anchorage School District. Very few ASD funds are used to maintain this field. The responsibility rest's with the Alliance.

American Legion Baseball is a non-profit group dedicated to improving the baseball fields for youths 14-18 in Alaska since 1967. The organization holds the responsibility for running the BP Invitational Tournament, the American Legion State Tournament, Todd Ryan Memorial in Wasilla, Midnight Sun Tournament in Fairbanks, and the Bill Miller Invitational in Kenai. Over the past several years, more and more of the financial burden to water, upgrade, replace, and renew Kosinski Field in Anchorage has fallen to American Legion Baseball. Estimated cost of maintaining fields in Anchorage, Kenai, Fairbanks, Wasilla, Eagle River, and Palmer has now exceeded \$50,000 a

Approximately 400 athletes participate in American Legion Baseball every year. Each team requires a minimum twelve man roster. Most teams play between 30-40 games over a three month period. Audiences vary in size from just parents for the in-season games to over a thousand fans over the three day BP Invitational Tournament. With such a short season, every available baseball field needs daily maintenance in order to make the playing surface safe for the athletes.
